Here is a bit of information about The Rosary

#### Origins:

The month was established by Pope Leo XIII in 1883 to honor Mary and encourage prayer for peace.

The devotion is also linked to the <u>Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary</u> on October 7th, which commemorates the Christian victory at the <u>Battle of Lepanto</u> in 1571 through the intercession of the Rosary.

#### Purpose:

The month provides an opportunity to focus on the Rosary, which is a series of prayers and meditations on the life of Jesus and Mary. It is a time for individual and family prayer, and for seeking Mary's intercession for personal intentions and peace.

#### How to participate:

Everyone is encouraged to pray the Rosary daily during October. Other ways to participate include learning more about the Rosary, getting involved in Rosary ministries, making a rosary or rosary bracelet, and sharing the prayer with others.











