Click download now, open, double click the file, click install. You should then see the font **next** time you open powerpoint or microsoft word.

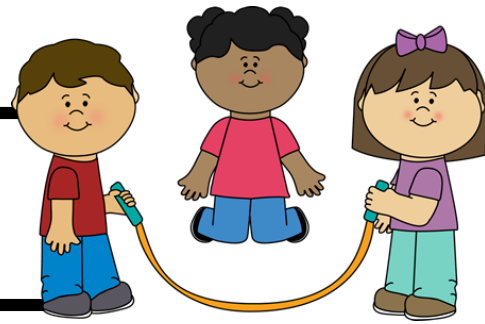
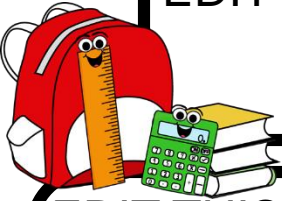
You may need to redownload this product to see the fonts appear correctly.
