## Here's What We're Working on:

**Christianity:** The Lord's Prayer

**Reading High Frequency Word:** the

Review: like, see, we, am, at, "a" (read as "ugh")

**Phonics/BTT Sound:** /p/

Spiraled Learning: Blending using these sounds: a, m, s, t, p to read/build/spell these words:

Pam, Pat, Sam, Tam, at, am, mat, map, tap

**Phonemic Awareness / Playing with words:** counting, blending, adding & deleting syllables, isolating sounds, rhyming words

**Writer's Workshop:** Adding details & color. Labeling illustrations - printing 1<sup>st</sup> letter (or more if able) to tell more of the "story"

**Math:** Continue 2D shapes: circle, square, triangle, rectangle, hexagon  
Numbers 0 - 10: Demonstrate 1 more, 1 less, # before, # after

**Science:** Life cycle of Pumpkins, parts of a pumpkin
