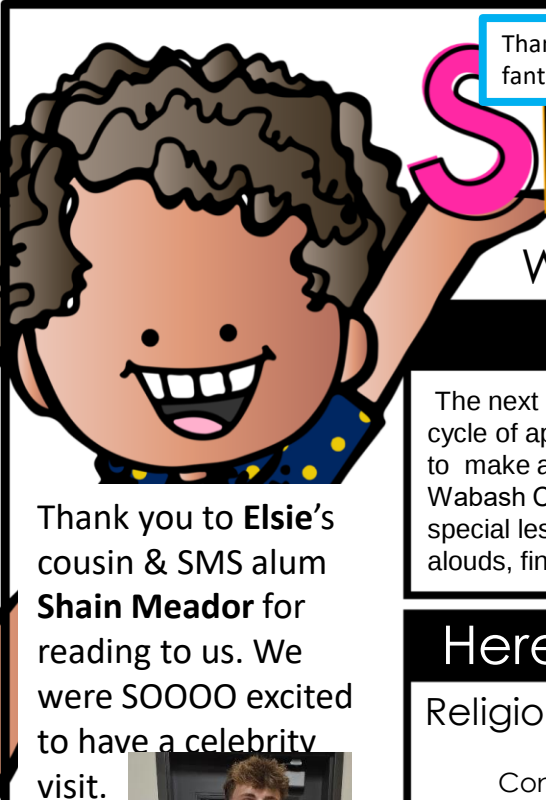




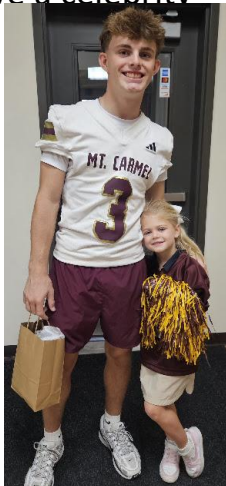

No More Show & Tell

Our ABC Boot Camp / Daily Show & Tell unit has concluded.
Monday we begin the very exciting **Unit 2** of Phonics! Your child has been assigned a day to bring an object with a chosen sound at the beginning, middle OR end of the word. This will develop listening for /hearing those sounds as we begin sounding out / decoding words! **This is where true reading happens!**
Have your child practice at home with your family so the "presentation" is smooth in class: "I brought a ____."
The sound I'd like you to listen for is ____ (either a, m, or s).
Do you hear the sound at the beginning, middle, or end of the word?" Your child will call on a student, hear the answer then respond: "Good try" "That's correct" "Nice job"
Each student will now have an **"assigned" day** of the week they will bring an item. **Remember: Items should fit INSIDE the backpack & not be valuable or fragile.**
